Release of HKDSE 2020 Examination Results

The HKDSE 2020 examination results will be released on 22 July 2020 and it is definitely a momentous occasion for all of us. As per the advice of the Education Bureau and in the light of the severe situation of the COVID-19 infections in Hong Kong, the HKDSE 2020 examination results will be released online, to safeguard the health of our students. The results will be released via Microsoft Teams Chat in the period from 8:30 a.m. to 9:15 a.m. that day. For this reason, S.6 students please check eClass notices these two days, and your class teachers will contact you in case you have forgotten your username or password. Please install eClass as well as Teams Apps in your electronic device, and procedures for receiving your results will be sent to you in due course.

The JUPAS office and local tertiary institutes will be informed of the examination results in the morning of 22 July 2020 so your electronic results notices will suffice, and indeed you need not come back to school to collect the hardcopies that day. Nonetheless, some students may need the hardcopies for different purposes so you may also opt to collect them from your class teachers in designated classrooms in the period from 9:30 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. The school will implement precautionary measures if students choose to come back to school to collect the hardcopies, with a view to minimizing the chance of infections.
