### Arrangements of Further Suspension of Face-to-Face Classes

Battered by the 4<sup>th</sup> wave of the COVID-19 pandemic fueled by escalating local infections, Hong Kong has ramped up the toughest measures since July. The Education Bureau (EDB) has announced that all schools will further suspend face-to-face classes up to **10 January 2021**. The EDB also strongly advocates that school staff and students should refrain from dining out, having crowd gatherings and travelling outside Hong Kong. In view of the further suspension of face-to-face classes, the school has the following arrangements:

#### Examinations and Assessment

- 1) The S.6 Mock Examination will be arranged as scheduled, from 4 January to 23 January 2021, as approval has been granted by the EDB for S.6 students to return to school to attend lessons or take internal examinations in preparation for the HKDSE Examination.
- 2) The S.1-5 Mid-Year Examination will commence from 11 January 2021 if face-to-face classes fully or partially resume.

#### Learning and Teaching

The school shall continue to adopt eLearning to facilitate students' learning at home, and as stated in the Notice dated 30 November 2020, a 7-lesson eLearning timetable will be used from 4 January 2021 onwards, in the light of the requirements for lesson hours according to the School Curriculum Framework, 2,754 lesson hours over 3 years for junior forms and 2,400 (+- 200) lesson hours over 3 years for senior forms. To offer more flexibility and space for students, there are five periods of 10-minute recess between lessons and the lunchtime is 1 hour 25 minutes long. To help students get into a routine, the timetable starts from 8:20 a.m. and ends at 3:45 p.m., just like a normal timetable.
