Francis Kong Educational Fund Scholarship for Undergraduate Studies

The 'Francis Kong Educational Fund Scholarship for Undergraduate Studies' was established in 2002 by the late Mr. Francis Kong. This Scholarship aims to provide financial assistance to students who need monetary support for their university studies, either locally or abroad. The scholarship will be awarded on a yearly basis and is renewable for a maximum of four years subject to the applicant's family financial condition and his academic progress.

Details of the scholarship are as follows:

Name of Award:	Francis Kong Educational Fund Scholarship for Undergraduate Studies
Duration of Award:	Maximum up to 4 years renewable annually
Value of Award:	HK\$10,000 per year (for applicants pursuing degree courses) HK\$5,000 per year (for applicants pursuing sub-degree courses)
Eligibility:	An applicant must fulfill the following criteria: (i) He must be a permanent resident of Hong Kong. (ii) He must have received at least 3 years of education in Wah Yan College, Kowloon without break by the end of the academic year in which the application is made. (iii) He must be offered a place in any of the recognized local tertiary institutions to pursue a degree or sub-degree course (iv) He must be in genuine need of financial assistance.
Application:	Application forms are available from June each year. All applications, including those for renewal, should reach the Careers Master of Wah Yan College, Kowloon by the end of August each year.
