The Hui Family Scholarship For Legal Studies

Background of the Hui Family

The Hui Family Scholarship For Legal Studies was established in 2023.

Three generations of the Hui Family have received Jesuits education and are lawyers. Dr Thomas Hui graduated from WYCHK in 1970. His brother, brothers in-law, nephew, sons and grandsons are all Wah Yan Boys. His son Mr Frederick Hui was educated in WYK. He is a solicitor advocate, notary public and arbitrator. He is a former School Manager of WYK and Pun U Assn. Wah Yan Primary School. He is also a former Vice Chairman of the WYKPSA. Frederick's sons are also Wah Yan Boys.

Objective

This Scholarship aims to provide financial assistance and encouragement to students who read law as their major in their university studies, either locally or abroad. Subject to the rules set out below, the Scholarship will be awarded one off to those who accept admission to a Bachelor of Laws Degree Programme or equivalent.

Details of the scholarship

Duration and Value of Award: HK\$5,000 one-off scholarship

Eligibility:

An applicant must fulfill the following criteria:

- (1) He must have received at least 3 years of education in Wah Yan College, Kowloon without break by the end of the academic year in which the application is made.
- (2) He must be offered a place (and he accepts the offer) in any of the recognized tertiary institutions to pursue a bachelor's degree in law.
- (3) He must be a person of good character.
- (4) He shares and promotes the Jesuits and Wah Yan Spirit.

Undertaking by Awardees: Awardees are required to donate an amount equivalent to the Value of the Award within five years after completing their degree studies. The donation is used to sustain the long-term operation of the Scholarship.

Application: Application forms will be available from June each year. All applications and enquiries should be directed to the Careers Mistress of Wah Yan College, Kowloon by the end of August each year.
